Spend time in a school either volunteering, on work

experience or just helping out.

Find out if you are eligible for the DARE scheme.
The Teacher Education colleges are now part of DARE, which recognises the effect of your disability and you may get in on a reduced points basis.

Make sure you have the right subjects to qualify.
You will need to reach the required standard in Irish and Maths for Initial teacher education.

for secondary teaching you must have a primary degree in the area you wish to teach in for example geography, plus the requisite teaching qualification. See the Teaching Council website for more info.

Think about what supports will help you become a teacher. This may include technology and learning supports or additional time to complete examinations.
